Shared with a maximum of just 15 other travellers, every classic moment feels freshly discovered.





Focus on East Africa's remarkable primate populations, with gorilla and chimpanzee trekking permits included.

This itinerary combines Rubondo Island's endemic chimpanzees with the gorilla population of Uganda's Bwindi Impenetrable Forest, and includes a cultural encounter with the Batwa people – learning about how their ancient traditional practices are being revitalised through a dedicated reforestation project.

BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- All rates are quoted on a per person basis.
- No single supplement for solo travellers.
- A maximum of two single rooms may be allocated per trip.
- Accommodation in the city hub is subject to availability and may be substituted with a similar standard alternative, if required, at the sole discretion of Asilia.
- Pricing is based on a minimum of 4 guests. Any reduction in guest numbers below the
 minimum may result in loss of group rates. The group departure is contingent upon at
 least 4 guests being confirmed 6 months prior to travel. A booking is only considered
 confirmed once the required deposit has been received and written confirmation has
 been issued by Asilia. If the minimum number of guests is not confirmed by this date,
 Asilia will contact you to discuss alternative options available.
- The minimum age requirement varies between 5 and 12 years and 15 years for primate-related activities.
- All rates are subject to change without prior notice due to fluctuations in park fees, foreign exchange rates, fuel prices, local taxes (including VAT or sales tax), third-party supplier adjustments, or other unforeseen factors outside Asilia's our control in the destination countries.
- Flights may require a minimum number of guests to proceed. If minimum thresholds
 are not met, alternatives will be discussed, and any necessary rate adjustments will be
 communicated accordingly.
- Cancellation, provisions, and deposit requirements are as are as set out in the Asilia Standard Booking Terms and Conditions.
- All guests are required to have adequate travel insurance in place prior to travel.
 Travel insurance is to be arranged by guests privately.
- All guests are required to sign a full indemnity prior to arrival.
