LOCATION | SETTING

Set in the vast and beautiful Arusha National Park, Hatari Lodge is nestled on the edge of a pristine woodland overlooking a glade called 'Momella meadow' with views of Mt. Kilimanjaro and Mt. Meru. Two of the natural world's most famous sisters, Mt. Kilimanjaro and Mt. Meru, are separated by only 60 kilometers, and can be enjoyed slope-to-slope within an 1.5 hour drive.

A legendary handmade bush lodge, once the setting for the 1962 Hollywood film, Hatari! Wild and romantic, the original farm buildings have been updated to house a central living and dining room, where guests gather round the warmth of the large stone fireplace or watch over the glade from the open deck.

ACCESS | ACCOMMODATION

International and Scheduled Flights: Kilimanjaro International Airport and Arusha Airport, both just over an hour from / to Hatari Lodge. No need to go through Arusha to connect to next safari destination as the Dolly Airstrip is less than an hour away, or take a stunning drive around Mt. Meru through African Steppe, making your way to the Northern Circuit Safari Highway.

Spacious en-suite rooms with cosy fireplaces and large verandas. Wake up on the foothills of Mt. Meru, with views of Mt. Kilimanjaro and enjoy breakfast with giraffes.

UNDER THE SKIES OF KILIMANJARO



LOCATION | SETTING

Shu'mata Camp is situated directly under the majestic Mount Kilimanjaro, in the hidden gem of the Enduimet Wildlife Management Area. Located adjacent to the UNESCO site Mt. Kilimanjaro National Park, to the south-east and its famed crater highlands, there are unlimited ways to enjoy this area along with the magnificent Great Rift Valley.

The Kenyan-Tanzania border sits to the north of the Enduimet Wildlife Management Area. About two hours' drive from Arusha National Park, there are over 1,000 square kilometers that encompass Ngurdoto crater, savannahs, lakes and vast plains filled with wildlife.

A permanent camp, set high on a ridge designed and positioned to capture stunning 360 degree views of the savannah and Kilimanjaro.

ACCESS | ACCOMMODATION

International and Scheduled Flights: Kilimanjaro International Airport & Arusha Airport.

Arriving from Kilimanjaro Airport, drive via Boma N'gombe, approx. 2 hours.

From Arusha Airport via Longido, approx. 2 hours drive.

From Hatari Lodge via Ngabobo, approx. 1 1/2 hour drive.

If guests arrive after 6pm, we recommend a night at Hatari first and then onto Shu'mata in the morning. From Shu'mata to West Kilimanjaro airstrip approx. 45 min drive.

Perfectly positioned to encompass the unique views across the wilderness and Mt. Kilimanjaro. Each of the seven tents is self contained with a full bath and private veranda.

A traditional safari camp, the interiors and décor have all been designed as a tribute to the bygone era and are chic and colorful.





TOP TRAVEL TIPS

Cash	Tanzanian currency is the Tanzanian Shilling (TZS). US\$ are accepted throughout Tanzania. Travel with small notes.

Travel Insurance	Mandatory, non-refundable travel insurance fee of US\$44.00 per person for all foreign nonresidents entering the country. This can be purchased on arrival at the airport or land border.
Passenger Facilitation Fee	International air passengers traveling to and from Tanzania will pay a new Passenger Facilitation Fee of \$45 USD per person for a one-way trip as of 1 November 2025. Automatically added to your air ticket price by the airline.

Day 1	Half day activity: Momella Lake game and scenic drive, sundowners at Hatari Lodge
Day 2	Full day activity: Mount Meru scenic drive and hike with a picnic at the waterfall
Day 3	Full day activity: Ngurdoto Crater game and scenic drive (crater hike - optional) OR Arusha National Park Game Drive
Day 4	Half day activity: SlowFood Gardens Visit - visit one of our four gardens for a botanical tour and breakfast
Day 5	Full day activity: Kili for All - Hike on Shira Plateau 3500m elevation and lunch at Simba Farm. Connect to Shu'Mata Camp

HALF DAY ACTIVITIES

Momella Lakes Tour

Half-day tour of Arusha National Park's seven volcanic lakes and their resident flamboyance of pink flamingos. Weather permitting either in the morning or afternoon. Guide included.

Canoeing on the small Momella Lakes

Half-day canoeing on one of the small Momella Lakes. Weather permitting either in the morning or afternoon. Guide included.

Momella Village Walk

Half-day walking activity from the lodge to the Momella Village to experience their culture. Scout included.

Ngurdoto Crater Tour

Half-day traversing this jewel in the jungle from Ngurdoto Forest to the central meadows and swamps. This activity is seasonal. Guide included. This is a drive. Walk not included in this activity.

Tululusia Waterfall Walk

Half-day walking safari from the lodge and back with a ranger on Mt Meru's slopes to view Colobus monkeys, buffaloes and giraffes on the way to the gorge of Tululusia Waterfall. Ranger and Scout included. Walks take place between 8:45 and 9:45am to avoid the crowds during high season.

Canyoning Waterfall Walk

Launching in 2026. Half day (beginner and advanced) guided hike and cultural tour at Materuni Waterfall, near the town of Moshi, a spectacular cascade that plummets 80 meters (262 feet) into a refreshing pool below. Minimum 12 years age restriction.

Historical Tour & Walk

Half-day following the tracks of Margaret Trappe. Walk from the one-exit grave and hunting area of Veterinary doc Nagi through the deep forest to the second grave of Margarete Trappe, the first white women hunter and elephant whisperer. It's a historical forest walk. Guide and Ranger included. Guests need to be fit as it is a long walk.

Slowfood Garden Visits

Half day activity whilst staying at Hatari Lodge, or en-route to other destinations. Visit one of our four gardens for a botanical tour and breakfast, lunch or tea in the garden.

All Activity Rates are based on a minimum of 2 people.

Activity single supplement: Double charge per activity for singles.

All activities need to be pre-booked and fully paid in advance to guarantee the activity.



FULL DAY ACTIVITIES

Mount Meru Tour

Full-day drive to the hidden Mt. Meru crater at 2 500m elevation, hiking inside the fog forest-covered amphitheater of the world's largest volcanic walls. Picnic at the waterfalls on your way down. Guide, Ranger and picnic included.

Tulusia Waterfall and Figtree Experience

Full-day walk to Tulusia waterfall with a drive to FigTree and a picnic at the waterfall. This is a great alternative to the Mount Meru Tour as the walk to Tulusia waterfall is less strenuous. Guide, Ranger and picnic included. Walks take place between 8:45 and 9:45am to avoid the crowds during high season.

Ngurdoto Crater Tour & Hike

Full day traversing this jewel in the jungle from Ngurdoto Forest to the central meadows and swamps with a rewarding picnic on the rim when coming back up again. Hike not possible during the wet season. Guide, Ranger and picnic included.

Arusha National Park Game Drive

Full-day spent in the Arusha National park with an all-day game viewing/adventure sightseeing in Meru forestland, the little Serengeti, hidden Ngongongare Springs and the Boma la Megi Viewpoint. Guide and picnic included.

Kilimanjaro For All - A Hike on Shira Plateau*

Full-day drive onto Kilimanjaro's Shira Plateau at 3 500m elevation and experience of the alpine mountain landscape on foot with lunch afterwards at Simba Farm. Guides included. Additional concession fees apply.

Arusha City Tour

Full-day tour to Arusha. It is a bustling, multi-cultural city that blends colonial heritage with modern Africa. Guide included. Extra charge for lunch.

Half-day early morning game-drive through acacia forest and seasonal swamps to the elephant retreats on the lower slopes of Kilimanjaro while also enjoying a bush breakfast. Guide included.

Kilimanjaro-Amboseli Ecosystem Afternoon Game Drive

Half-day late afternoon game-drive through acacia forest and seasonal swamps to the elephant retreats on the lower slopes of Kilimanjaro. Ending off the day with sundowners. Guide and one drink per person included.

Supplement: Guided Walk in the Footsteps of Elephants

Enhance your Kilimanjaro-Amboseli Ecosystem morning or evening Game Drive with a guided walk accompanied by an armed Ranger to find Africa's most majestic animals. Ranger included.

Sundown Spear Throw

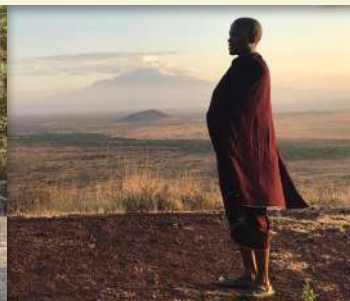
