- + South Luangwa is Zambia's oldest and perhaps most prolific National Park. Often referred to as the Valley of the Leopard leopard sightings here are plentiful year-round, with an average of 1 leopard per kilometre of river!
- + A fabulous range of camps, from luxury safari tents at Chinzombo to our authentic and sustainable seasonal camps, that combine unrivalled wildlife experiences in raw and remote areas with refined creature comforts.
- + Home of the walking safari, one of our founders, Norman Carr is acknowledged as the father and pioneer of the walking safari in Africa. That legacy lives on today.
- + Excellent wild dog, lion and plain game. Birding is also particularly good over our secret season months.
- + Home to several endemic species such as Cooksons Wildebeest, Crayshaw Zebra and Thornicroft Giraffe.

- + Situated under a canopy of winterthorn trees, Chongwe is elephant heaven. These gentle giants are commonly found wandering around and in front of the house, hoovering up the pods that fall from these trees.
- + Chongwe offers 9 safari tents with en-suite bathrooms at Chongwe Camp, with 2 separate luxury Suites nearby (Albida & Cassia), and a standalone, 4-bedroom House which come with a private guide and vehicle as well as its own chef/kitchen and team.
- + A vast array of experiences and game viewing opportunities. A land and water based safari, with the boating and tiger fishing being great highlights. Activities are super flexible can be combined to make the most of both the land and the mighty Zambezi river e.g. Guests can start their afternoon with a canoe along the scenic Nkalanga channel, pausing to watch the elephants drink from the river. After sundowners, guests will meet a vehicle and enjoy a night drive back to the camp.
