These initiatives empower communities to achieve selfsufficiency, thereby establishing the groundwork for economic growth, job creation, and enhanced wellbeing.



In 1998 Fiona established Just a Drop with the aim of promoting social responsibility within the travel and tourism industry.

With extensive connections in the travel sector, Fiona has held prominent positions such as Chairman of World Travel Market and membership on the UN World Committee for Tourism Ethics.

Fiona's enduring dedication to African development is evident through her continued involvement with ATTA, where she has served as a board member since 2014 and Chair from 2018 to 2020.

Just a Drop in Africa

Since our establishment in 1998, Just a Drop has been actively engaged in Africa.

Our first initiative took place in Ethiopia, where we provided safe water and organised community health programmes for 30,000 people.

Since then, our efforts have extended to 11 African nations, culminating in 236 completed projects that have supported approximately 834,685 people.

In addition to our core projects, we take immense pride in our community development endeavours. These encompass diverse initiatives such as soap making, sustainable agriculture, microfinance programmes, and menstrual health and hygiene initiatives, including manufacturing reusable sanitary products.

Our commitment is fortified by our collaboration with esteemed African partners like the Africa Sand Dam Foundation (ASDF). We ensure that projects actively engage local communities in both the installation and maintenance of water solutions. By working alongside local self-help groups (SHGs), we also facilitate development training to empower communities.







Just a Drop in Kenya

Just a Drop has been working in Kenya since 2011 and we have completed over 140 projects. In Kenya our projects consist of:

Sand Dams and Rock Catchments

Remarkable sustainable water dams that store up to 10 million litres of safe water, raising local water tables and providing multiple villages water

Just a Drop in Zambia

Just a Drop has been working in Zambia since 2010 and we have completed 62 projects. In Zambia our projects consist of:

Drilled Boreholes

Building secure water sources for communities and educating locals on borehole maintenance.

Borehole Rehabilitations

Restoring non-functional or damaged boreholes and providing community training in borehole maintenance.

Schools (Rainwater Tanks, Latrines, & Hand Washing Stations)

Providing safe water access through rainwater guttering systems and improving hygiene facilities for students and staff

Training in:

Menstrual Hygiene Management
Water, Hygiene and Sanitation (WASH)


Our projects change thousands of lives every year!

Through our sand dams and rainwater harvesting work we mitigate the impact of climate change and many of our projects also include elements such as tree planting and drought resistant agriculture.





Hotel Partnerships

GREEN HOUSEKEEPING

'Tap Water For All is a fundraising initiative for the hospitality industry. Completely free to set up and run, with all materials provided by Just a Drop, this campaign encourages guests to donate £1 per table when they order tap water - or a water based product. Not only is it a remarkable initiative that is easy to implement, but it also enhances business ESG and the sustainability profile, while crucially addressing the global water crisis

Green-Housekeeping is implemented by our partner hotels, offering guests the choice to opt out of daily housekeeping in exchange for a hotel reward, such as a restaurant voucher, a bottle of wine, or travel points. This initiative not only helps the hotel save on service charges but also donates £1 to Just a Drop each time Green-Housekeeping is selected by a guest. All promotional materials are provided by Just a Drop, making it a straightforward and effective approach to bolster a hotel's sustainability profile with minimal operational requirements


